Safety and compliance

- Safety and compliance has been good during the last period



Organisational restructuring

- Company-wide reorganisation progressing
- Work now organised in programmes with regional site leads
- Site Director now retitled Closure Director



Lifetime Plan

- Updated Sizewell A Lifetime Plan developed to reflect information in the Cavendish Fluor Partnership bid
- Main changes (subject to appropriate approvals):
 - No ILW interim storage facility
 - FED packaged for disposal at LLWR Repository
 - Conventional demolition closer to closure date

Projects update

- Two redundant depleted uranium test weights were disposed of during August.
- Asbestos encapsulation completed on all four boilers. Work underway to clad the four apertures, ensuring the area is secured until final asbestos stripping. Meanwhile, maintenance work on the boiler house roofs is underway to ensure they are watertight.
- A new electrical and fire system has been installed, tested and commissioned in an area that will be used as a Low Level Waste facility before the waste is removed from the site.

Draft socio-economic plan

- Draft Magnox socio-economic plan will be made available on 30 September for stakeholder feedback and comment.
- Formal correspondence notifying stakeholders that the draft plan is available will be issued.
- Mailbox address for feedback will be made available.
- Consultation on the plan will run from 30 September – 16 November 2015.
- Final plan expected by end of the calendar year.
