1. Anna Clark from NDA started off by introducing the day welcomed everyone to the workshop day. Listening Mode was the aim of the day
2. Richard Harris, Independent Facilitator, went through the purposes of the day evolving the Reactor Decommissioning Strategy for the NDA and looking at factors on how decisions are made.
3. Introductions Simon Boniface from NDA, Jill Thomas AGR Nuclear Liabilities, Jonathon Jenkins, Gillian Cohen and 1 other.
4. Matthew Tilsley, Kevin MacIntyre, Darren Bridgewater all attended to support the process of the day from Magnox.
5. All tables introduced each other, and then the programme was discussed looking at Factors regarding the strategy.
6. The Factors were broken down into 7 areas which were:
  - a. Managing Risk to people
  - b. Protecting the Environment
  - c. Socio Economic Impact
  - d. Enabling the Mission
  - e. Resources
  - f. Logistics
  - g. Lifetime Costs
7. Each Table had to discuss each of the factors as a start point to the strategy, and many varied and different opinions were giving by the stakeholders that attended the meeting.
8. As this was the start of the strategy discussions many members advised that sites would/could have a different consideration to those in the groups that were sat around the tables.
9. In essence the day ended with agreement that there were many factors that needed to be clarified for sites but also there were many factors that had examples of cross references from each of the factors.
10. We will look forward to the next steps and hopefully some consultation with the SSGs at a future date
