Safety performance and staffing

During the period of the report there has been:

- **No lost time injuries to staff**
- **No nuclear reportable incidents**
- **No environmental incidents**

- **549 EDF Energy staff includes 16 Apprentices, 4 Engineering trainees, 2 Chemistry trainees, 2 Industrial Placements**

- **250 year round contracting partners**



Turbine Generator (TG)1 works

- In August we shutdown TG1 to complete repairs to a section of pipework.
- We also took the opportunity to bring forward planned work to Generator Transformer 1.
- TG1 outage was for 32 hrs - TG2 was not affected during this time.



Company News

- New figures released by the Government show that companies in the South West have now won contracts worth more than £1.3 billion for the Hinkley Point C nuclear power station in Somerset.
- Hinkley Point C is making good progress with 3,200 workers on site in Somerset. It remains on target for its next milestone, in mid-2019, when construction rises above ground level and the first electricity is due from site in 2025.



Sizewell and the Community

- In September Simone Rossi, EDF Energy Chief Executive, met with a number of community groups with a range of interests in the Sizewell C project.



EDF Energy New recruits - Apprentices

- EDF Energy has 26 new apprentices, including 10 female apprentices in 2018 cohort, training at the National College for Nuclear (NCfN) in Cannington, Somerset.
- 4 new engineering apprentices for Sizewell B studying NCfN, where they will spend the next two years - 2019 applications now open.
