

Magnox Socio-economic Funding in the Community

2017/18 Socio-economic scheme update

In 2017/18, over £739k was committed to helping 143 organisations across the 12 Magnox sites through the Magnox Socio-economic scheme.

Over £319k (43%) of this was in the surrounding communities of Wylfa site.

Some of groups that benefited from the Good Neighbour level funding were:



Llanfair FC Under 15's – awarded £500 funding for their Magnox branded kit for the new football season.

Ysgol Friars Outdoor Activity Club - awarded £560 to purchase a mountain leader first aid kit and 3 bouldering kits which has benefited over 100 young individuals. Significantly more pupils have been able to participate and experience climbing locally through workshops for all abilities.



Cylch Meithrin Amlwch – awarded £400 for two mud kitchens to assist with learning through play.

One of the larger, transformational applications recently supported is the £1.7m Capel Bethlehem Project in Cemaes.

Recently formed Cemaes Community Interest Group secured £150,000 Magnox funding towards the creation of an all year round, sustainable tourist destination in the prime location of the village, overlooking the harbour and beach.



The project will refurbish the main chapel into a chef-school model 100 cover restaurant for a 10 year lease to an established chef/restaurateur, giving the opportunity for local students to gaining accredited qualifications.

The project will create five new business enterprises; three direct and 26 indirect employment opportunities within the restaurant, two shops and holiday let, a 72 seat cinema, 15 voluntary employment opportunities for the visitor attraction and over 200 training and skills development opportunities.

2018/19

The Magnox Socio-economic scheme portal was closed for a couple of weeks at the beginning of April 2018 to revise documents and implement improvements. The system is now open and accepting new applications.

The scheme provides funding to support activities that benefit the social or economic life of communities, in support of the NDA's responsibilities under the Energy Act (2004) to mitigate the socio-economic impact of its work programme where it operates. The scheme has three funding aims:

1. Being a good neighbour
2. Helping to build sustainable communities
3. Supporting transformational projects that mitigate the impact of decommissioning Magnox sites.

Funding is available on a rolling programme and prioritised towards aims 2 and 3, where the biggest and most sustainable socio-economic benefit can be achieved.

Diweddariad am gynllun economaidd-gymdeithasol 2017/18

Yn 2017/18, ymrwymwyd dros £739,000 i helpu 143 o sefydliadau ar draws 12 safle Magnox drwy gynllun economaidd-gymdeithasol Magnox.

Roedd dros £319,000 (43%) o hyn mewn cymunedau sy'n lleol i Wylfa.

Clwb Pêl-droed dan 15 oed Llanfairpwll – dyfarnwyd £500 o arian ar gyfer eu cit â logo Magnox arno ar gyfer y tymor pêl-droed newydd.

Clwb Gweithgareddau Awyr Agored Ysgol Friars

- dyfarnwyd £560 i brynu cit cymorth cyntaf arweinydd mynydd a 3 chit bowldro er budd dros 100 o unigolion ifanc. Mae nifer fwy o lawer o ddisgyblion wedi llwyddo i gymryd rhan a rhoi cynnig ar ddringo yn lleol drwy weithdai i ddringwyr o bob gallu.



Cylch Meithrin Amlwch – dyfarnwyd £400 ar gyfer dwy gegin mwd i gynorthwyo dysgu drwy chwarae.

Un o'r ceisiadau trawsffurfiol mwy o faint a gefnogwyd yn ddiweddar yw Prosiect Capel Bethlehem, sy'n werth £1.7 miliwn, yng Nghemaes.

Yn ddiweddar, fe wnaeth Grŵp Buddiannau Cymunedol Cemaes sicrhau £150,000 o arian Magnox tuag at greu cyrchfan twristiaeth gynaliadwy drwy gydol y flwyddyn, yn un o brif leoliadau'r pentref, yn edrych dros yr harbwr a'r traeth.



Bydd y prosiect yn adnewyddu'r prif gapel i fod yn fwyty ar ffurf ysgol cogyddion gyda lle i 100 o bobl fwyta, ar brydles 10 mlynedd i gogydd/perchennog bwyty sefydledig, gan roi cyfle i fyfyrwyr lleol ennill cymwysterau achrededig.

Bydd y prosiect yn creu pum menter busnes newydd; tri chyfle cyflogaeth uniongyrchol a 26 o gyfleoedd cyflogaeth anuniongyrchol yn y bwyty, dwy siop a llety gwyliau, sinema 72 sedd, 15 o gyfleoedd gwirfoddoli ar gyfer yr atyniad i ymwelwyr a thros 200 o gyfleoedd hyfforddi a datblygu sgiliau.

2018/19

Caewyd porth cynllun economaidd-gymdeithasol Magnox am ychydig wythnosau ar ddechrau mis Ebrill 2018 i ddiwygio dogfennau a gwneud gwelliannau. Mae'r system bellach yn agored unwaith eto ac yn derbyn ceisiadau newydd.

Mae cynllun yn darparu cyllid i gefnogi gweithgareddau sydd o fudd i fywyd cymdeithasol neu economaidd cymunedau, er mwyn cefnogi cyfrifoldebau'r NDA dan Ddeddf Ynni (2004) i leihau effaith economaidd-gymdeithasol ei raglen waith yn yr ardaloedd lle mae'n gweithio. Mae gan y cynllun dri nod o ran cyllido:

1. Bod yn gymydog da
2. Helpu i greu cymunedau cynaliadwy
3. Cefnogi prosiectau trawsnewid sy'n lleihau effaith datgomisiynu safleoedd Magnox.

Mae cyllid ar gael ar ffurf rhaglen dreigl, a chaiff ei flaenoriaethu tuag at nodau 2 a 3, lle mae modd cyflawni'r budd economaidd-gymdeithasol mwyaf cynaliadwy a mwyaf o ran maint.
