The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting at 1.05 and noted the following apologies.

**2. Approve the Minutes of the meeting held on 4 December 2017**

Minutes of the meeting held on 4 December 2017 were presented and accepted as a correct record.

**3. Matters arising from the minutes of the meeting held on 4 December 2017**

None raised

**4. Chairman's Address – Keith O'Brien**

The Chair gave an overview of his activities since the last meeting and drew particular attention to the following:-

- a) Meeting of all SSG Chairs held on 24 February 2018 in London where particular reference was made to the positive work being undertaken at Trawsfynydd.
- b) The expectancy that the Holliday Report will be finalised late summer early Autumn 2018.
- c) Meeting held with Simon Boniface NDA Decommissioning Strategy Manager regarding continuous de-commissioning. He noted the importance of reminding all parties of the role of Welsh Government and the implications should there be a decision to identify 2 areas; one in England and one in Wales.
- d) The Chair was unable to attend the BEIS workshop in Bangor but noted that JLR would provide members with a briefing.
- e) Noted that this morning's site visit and tour by SSG members proved useful and informative. Members had been impressed with current progress and the general cleanliness on site. The Chair encouraged all to attend future visits.
- f) NDA National Stakeholder Summit event to be held at Berkeley College – 10/11 July 2018

Finally the Chair referred to the retirement of Gareth Lloyd, Senior Planner with Snowdonia National Park Authority and thanked him for his support and wished him well in the future.

BSE workshop – JLR update

JLR reported on the BEIS workshop held in Bangor on 14 June 2018 which focused on the consultation on the regulation of nuclear sites in the final stages of decommissioning. He referred to the Nuclear Installations Act 1965 and its statutory requirements and the need for appropriate funding to meet those requirements. He noted that whilst the ONR will be the administrators the HSE and NRW will also be part of the process. JLR also referred to the BEIS consultation which will close on 3 July and SSG members were encouraged to access the website in order to complete.

The Chair thanked JLR for his briefing.

## **5. Site Closure Director's Report – Martin Moore**

The Chair introduced Martin Moore, Trawsfynydd Site Closure Director to the meeting. Mr Moore guided members through his report previously circulated to members. He drew particular attention to the following:-

### **Safety Overview**

- a) Safety performance over the year was good overall, with TRIR/DACR rates remaining at zero and a reduction in the incidence of First Aid treatments.
- b) Local safety priorities have been addressed through campaigns such as “hold the handrail”, and having our own teams share their personal stories and reflections.
- c) Focussing now on staff health and well-being, at work and beyond. AR has developed a video for a recent Safety Representatives Conference, explaining how staff care for each other and it was agreed to show SSG members this video at the next meeting.
- d) Positive work being undertaken as regards protection of the Environment
- e) Security performance continues to be of a high standard with revised arrangements established to increase resilience and support the cessation of operational shift working. This project was very well planned and executed, and has provided the basis for the remaining Magnox sites to follow.

### **Quality Assurance**

AR reported that Trawsfynydd continues to trial the Magnox Quality Assurance Matrix for a second year. She noted that the document recovery project continues with a reduction of overdue documents from an average of 2,500 at any one time to below 500 to date and this downward trend continues.

A Site Assurance Review Audit conducted by the Head of Internal Audit on 11.6.18 has received a positive feedback with minor findings to be addressed.

### **Decommissioning Progress**

MM noted excellent progress across the site with a number of impressive milestones achieved through the year, in summary:

- a) Lockdown of both safestores above ground floor was completed after an extensive package of work to remove legacy waste and remove or make safe any radiological or asbestos hazard.
- b) Completion of the Main Sludge Vault recovery, with the team managing a very difficult waste stream without incident or harm. The plant will now enter Post Operational Clean Out ahead of handover for de-planting works.
- c) The North Fuel Element Debris (FED) Plant entered active commissioning and we have produced nine 3m<sup>3</sup> intermediate level waste packages (ILW) of FED.
- d) Completion of the Pond scabbling phase, and we are now focused on backing out of the ponds lanes, with all Ponds North Void baskets removed and safely exported into storage in the Magnox Debris Handling & Storage Facility.
- e) Completion of the Reactor Building strengthening works without any significant incidents.

As regards the new Guidance on Requirements for Release of Nuclear Sites from Radioactive Substances Regulations, a constructive and productive working relationship with NDA, ONR, EA, and Snowdonia National Park has been established with positive feedback to date from all parties.

## **Workforce**

The workforce numbers are expected to decrease in line with a planned reduction in work scope. MM provided members with a high level report on staffing statistics as follows:-

April 2017 -	445 staff (all staff including direct site License Company, agencies and others)
April 2018 -	326
June 2018 -	268

MM reiterated that there is a continued effort to strive for open dialogue between management and staff.

As part of supporting the Magnox Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) Programme all staff and agency workers have attended awareness workshops to help make EDI visible and understood in the workplace.

Mental Health First Aiders have been appointed and a number of Managers have received training to help in identifying stress, building resilience & healthy minds for themselves and their teams.

Succession planning continues to ensure a smooth transition in September 2019 when the Parent Body Organisation (PBO) Contract between Cavendish Fluor Partnership and the NDA is mutually terminated.

## **Environment and Radiological Safety**

AR reported that during this last period the site has maintained discharges to the environment at very low levels, significantly below the annual permitted limits. Radiation protection remains within discharge limits.

Cllr M Williams enquired as to the date for demolition and who makes that decision. MM stated that work is planned to commence in 2022, but that specific details of work schedules will be determined once a demolition contractor is selected. He noted that discussions with all parties are ongoing to agree the detail and complete the agreement and to help understand what is required within the required Planning Application.

Cllr Richards remarked that the SSG had not received a draft Business Plan for a few years and commented that this was a useful document. He also stated that he had been informed that funds had been removed from the Trawsfynydd budget – he enquired as to the validity of this statement. MM confirmed that the funding from the NDA had been lower this year than in previous years but in line with the planned work on the site. He explained that cost effective activity within one site can result in release of funds to another, and sometimes priorities change and funding can be redirected. Likewise, if high priority work is identified in Trawsfynydd in the future, management can request additional funding to cover such costs.

Cllr Ioan Thomas wished to thank MM for the site visits earlier in the day and also for providing the staffing profile data.

## **6. Report by the Office for Nuclear Regulation – John McGough**

There was no representative from ONR present; however, a written report covering the period 1.10.17 to 31.3.18 had been circulated with the papers.

## **7. Report by Natural Resources Wales – Julia Frost**

There was no representative of NRW present, however, a joint written report, prepared by NRW and EA, was distributed to all SSG members and discussed at Item 10 below.

## **8. Report by the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority – Jonathan Jenkin**

Mr Jonathon Jenkin was welcomed to the meeting and gave a brief overview of the NDA monthly update previously circulated to members. He referred specifically to the imminent NDA Stakeholder Summit to be held in Berkeley, a former nuclear site now housing the South Gloucester and Stroud College and Science Park, during 10-11 July 2018.

He reiterated that the decommissioning document will hopefully be presented to the July NDA Board meeting. If the document receives Board approval it will then be presented to Government before undergoing a full consultation process.

## **9. Magnox socio-economic scheme update – Mair Jones**

Mair Jones gave a short presentation on the achievements of the socio-economic scheme. It was noted that in 2017/18, over £739k was committed to helping 143 organisations across the 12 Magnox sites. Over £140k (19%) of this was in the surrounding communities of Trawsfynydd site. Some of the groups that benefited from the Good Neighbour level funding were:

Blaenau Sovereigns – awarded £1000; Cylch Meithrin Bethel – awarded £315; Eisteddfod Gadeiriol Deiniolen a'r Cylch – awarded £418; Harlech Library – awarded £2000

One of the larger, transformational applications recently supported were Outdoor Partnership – awarded £30,000; Dyffryn Nantlle Community Hub – awarded £9,999; STEM Gogledd Project – awarded £201,000.

Also, Trawsfynydd Transition Phase 3 received £465,500 NDA direct funding towards the end of the financial year. This is a continuation of phase 2, which received £350,000 funding in 2011/12 creating two jobs – Enterprise Zone Manager and Enterprise Zone Officer implementing the Site Action Plan and further improvements to the Trawsfynydd Lake, such as improved access for paths and cyclists and signage and the tourism café which created five indirect jobs. Phase 3 is a much broader programme with the opportunity to secure major multimillion pound investments at both Trawsfynydd with the potential Small Modular Reactor (SMR) opportunity and the nearby Snowdonia Aerospace Centre in Llanbedr.

The Chair wished to formally thank Mair Jones and Magnox Ltd for administrating and delivering this valuable funding to support local projects and encouraged members to promote the fund in their localities.

## **10. Environment Agency Report – Richard Clarke**

Mr Richard Clarke was welcomed to the meeting and guided members through the joint NRW/EA report previously circulated to members. He drew particular attention to the following:-

- a) Radioactive discharges – 1/4ly reports received all show that Trawsfynydd remains within the limits set in the radioactive substances permit.
- b) Asset Management Themed Inspection was held by NRW on 5-6 May – feedback imminent
- c) No Enforcement Activity was concluded since the last meeting
- d) Formal GRR trail has been completed, but work continues with Trawsfynydd on the completion of formal submissions in conjunction with ONR,NDA as well as Snowdonia National Park
- e) Warning letter issued July 2017 re misconsignment of pond scabbling waste. Good progress undertaken by the operator which will be formally recorded in the site inspection report.
- f) Noted that a Trawsfynydd ‘Habits’ survey will be undertaken early in July – Sion Richards and Richard Clarke will lead on this within the local community.
- g) Reiterated that, from the EA point of view, there is a lot of work to be done yet before a formal Planning Application can be completed. He assured members that there is a lot of positive dialogue ongoing between all agencies. He also stated that the usual timeline for consultations is between 6-8 weeks.

Mr Clarke was thanked for his presentation.

## **11. AOB**

Menter Eryri, Cyngor Gwynedd

Nia Bowden wished to update members on the following:-

### **Trawsfynydd**

- Efforts are continuing to lobby for continuous decommissioning.
- Site development – number of parties have visited the site and positive comments received as regards housing a smaller reactor
- Twf Application – a number of projects have been identified to be developed over the next 15 years

## **Llanbedr**

- Funds identified to renew the site and buildings, upgrade equipment and improve site access – slow progress, however, European funding has been confirmed.
- Institution of Mechanical Engineering event to be held for children and young people.

Cllr M Williams referred to a recent incident whereby an airplane (- Floatplane) was seen on the lake. No one present was able to provide any detail or information regarding this incident and it was agreed that A.Mc from Maentwrog and JJ from the NDA investigate further and report back to the next meeting of this group.

Adroddodd AR bod Trawsfynydd yn parhau i dreialu Matrics Sicrhau Ansawdd Magnox am ail flwyddyn. Nododd bod y prosiect adfer dogfennau yn parhau gyda gostyngiad o ddogfennau hwyr o 2,500, ar gyfartaledd ar unrhyw adeg, i lai na 500, hyd yma, ac mae'r gostyngiad hwn yn parhau.

Mae Archwiliad Adolygu Sicrwydd y Safle a gafodd ei gynnal gan y Pennaeth Archwilio Mewnol ar 11.6.18 wedi derbyn adborth cadarnhaol gyda mân ganfyddiadau i fynd i'r afael â nhw.

### **Y Cynnydd o ran Datgomisiynu**

Nododd MM gynnydd ardderchog ar draws y safle gyda nifer o gerrig milltir arbennig wedi'u cyflawni gydol y flwyddyn, yn cynnwys yn fras:

- a) Cau'r ddwy storfa ddiogel uwchben lefel y ddaear ar ôl pecyn o waith helaeth i waredu gwastraff etifeddol a gwaredu neu ddiogelu unrhyw beryglon radiologol neu asbestos.

- e) Cwblhawyd y gwaith ar gryfhau Adeilad yr Adweithyddion heb unrhyw ddigwyddiadau sylweddol.

Yng nghyswllt y Canllawiau newydd ar Ofynion Rhyddhau Safleoedd Niwclear rhag Rheoliadau Sylweddau Ymbelydrol, mae perthynas waith adeiladol a chynhyrchiol wedi'i sefydlu gyda'r NDA, y Swyddfa Rheoleiddio Niwclear, Asiantaeth yr Amgylchedd a Pharc Cenedlaethol Eryri, gydag adborth cadarnhaol hyd yma gan bob parti.

Fel rhan o gefnogi Rhaglen Cydraddoldeb, Amrywiaeth a Chynhwysiant (EDI) Magnox mae'r holl staff a gweithwyr asiantaeth wedi mynychu gweithdai ymwybyddiaeth i helpu i wneud Cydraddoldeb, Amrywiaeth a Chynhwysiant yn weladwy a sicrhau eu bod yn cael eu deall yn y gweithle.

Mae Swyddogion Cymorth Cyntaf Iechyd Meddwl wedi cael eu penodi a nifer o Reolwyr wedi cael hyfforddiant i'w helpu i ganfod straen, meithrin gwytnwch a meddwl iach ar eu cyfer eu hunain a'u timau.

Mae cynllunio ar gyfer olyniaeth yn parhau i sicrhau cyfnod pontio llyfn ym Medi 2019 pan fydd y Contract Sefydliad Corff Rhiant (PBO) rhwng Partneriaeth Cavendish Fluor a'r NDA yn dod i ben.

### **Yr amgylchedd a Diogelwch Radiolegol**

Dywedodd AR, yn ystod y cyfnod olaf hwn, bod y safle wedi cynnal lefel y gollyngiadau i'r amgylchedd ar lefelau isel iawn, yn sylweddol is na'r terfynau blyneddol a ganiateir. Mae diogelu rhag ymbelydredd yn parhau o fewn y terfynau ar gyfer gollyngiadau.

Holodd y Cyng. M Williams ynghylch y dyddiad ar gyfer dymchwel a phwy sy'n gwneud y penderfyniad. Dywedodd MM bod y gwaith wedi'i gynllunio i ddechrau yn 2022, ond y bydd manylion penodol o ran amserlenni gwaith yn cael eu pennu pan fydd contractwr dymchwel wedi'i ddewis a'i gytuno. Nododd fod trafodaethau gyda'r holl bartion yn mynd rhagddynt i gytuno ar y manylion a chwblhau'r cytundeb ac er mwyn helpu i ddeall beth sydd angen ei wneud yn y Cais Cynllunio gofynnol.

Gwnaeth y Cyng. Richards sylw nad oedd y Grŵp Rhanddeiliaid Safle wedi derbyn Cynllun Busnes Drafft am rai blyneddol, gan nodi bod hon yn ddogfen ddefnyddiol. Dywedodd hefyd ei fod wedi cael ei hysbysu y tynnwyd arian o gyllideb Trawsfynydd – holodd am ddilysrwydd y datganiad hwn. Cadarnhaodd MM bod y cyllid gan yr NDA wedi bod yn is eleni nag yn y gorffennol ond yn unol â'r gwaith a

## **8. Adroddiad gan yr Awdurdod Datgomisiynu Niwclear – Jonathan Jenkin**

Croesawyd Mr Jonathon Jenkin i'r cyfarfod a rhoddodd olwg gyffredinol ar ddiweddariad misol yr NDA a oedd eisoes wedi ei gylchredeg i'r aelodau. Cyfeiriodd yn benodol at Uwchgynhadledd Rhanddeiliaid yr NDA a oedd i'w chynnal yn Berkeley, hen safle niwclear sydd erbyn hyn yn gartref i Goleg a Pharc Gwyddoniaeth De Caerloyw a Stroud, yn ystod y 10-11 Gorffennaf 2018.

Pwysleisiodd eto'r gobaith y bydd y ddogfen datgomisiynu'n cael ei chyflwyno i gyfarfod Bwrdd yr NDA ym mis Gorffennaf. Os bydd y ddogfen yn derbyn cymeradwyaeth y Bwrdd yna bydd yn cael ei chyflwyno i'r Llywodraeth cyn mynd drwy broses ymgynghori lawn.

## **9. Diweddariad ar gynllun-economaidd gymdeithasol Magnox – Mair Jones**

Rhoddodd Mair Jones gyflwyniad byr ar lwyddiannau'r cynllun economaidd-gymdeithasol. Nodwyd, yn 2017/18, y cafodd dros £739k ei ymrwmo i helpu 143 o sefydliadau ar draws y 12 safle Magnox. Yr oedd dros £140,000 (19%) o hyn mewn cymunedau o gwmpas safle Trawsfynydd. Dyma rai o'r grwpiau sydd wedi elwa o arian lefel Cymydog Da:

Blaenau Sovereigns – dyfarnwyd £1000, Cylch Meithrin Bethel – dyfarnwyd £315, Eisteddfod Gadeiriol Deiniolen a'r Cylch – dyfarnwyd £418; Llyfrgell Harlech – dyfarnwyd £2000

Un o'r ceisiadau trawsnewid mwy a gefnogwyd yn ddiweddar oedd y Bartneriaeth Awyr Agored – dyfarnwyd £30,000, Hwb Cymunedol Dyffryn Nantlle – dyfarnwyd £9,999; Prosiect STEM y Gogledd – dyfarnwyd £201,000.

Hefyd, cafodd Rhaglen Trawsnewid Trawsfynydd Cam 3 £465,500 o gyllid uniongyrchol gan NDA tua diwedd y flwyddyn ariannol. Mae hyn yn barhad o gam 2,

a dderbyniodd £350,000 o gyllid yn 2011/12 gan greu dwy swydd – Rheolwr yr Ardal Fenter a Swyddog yr Ardal Fenter, rhoi Cynllun Gweithredu'r Safle ar waith a gwneud rhagor o welliannau i Lyn Trawsfynydd, fel mynediad gwell ar gyfer llwybrau a weicwyr ac arwyddion a'r caffï i dwristiaid a greodd bump o swyddi anuniongyrchol. Mae Cam 3 yn rhaglen llawer mwy eang gyda'r cyfle i sicrhau buddsoddiadau mawr gwerth sawl miliwn yn Nhrawsfynydd gyda'r potensial i gael Adweithydd Modiwlwr Bach (SMR) a Chanolfan Awyrofod Eryri gerllaw yn Llanbedr.
