Bradwell transition

Demobilisation work continues at Bradwell and is progressing well. The majority of the office accommodation is now demolished.

Final waste processing is in progress and all shipments off-site are planned to be completed by the summer.


The site will continue to receive intermediate level waste (ILW) packages from Dungeness A and eventually Sizewell A for storage in the site's interim storage facility (ISF).

Plant and Structures update

National Grid building - hazard removal and demolition

Work continues to progress well and during May the following is planned to be completed:

- Final internal asbestos removal
- Demolition of the generator room
- Scrap processing
- Final de-plant of all non-structural steelwork
- **Final demolition planned for early July 2019**

Ponds Programme update

The focus for the ponds team continues with the removal of waste from the ponds and cleaning the walls as draining of pond water is carried out.

So far the team has managed to remove approximately 640 m³ of pond water from the pond which is approximately 22% of the overall volume of water within the pond.

Removal of items continues, with 31 LLW waste skips containing size-reduced pond furniture removed and handed over to Waste Operations.

Asset Care Projects update

The site continues to work to remove the asbestos hazard at site and this work is on-going this year with a programme of work in place.

People and transition

There is currently 170 staff on site, this includes contract supplied workers, agency supplied workers and Magnox staff.

Community Relations

In 2018 – 2019, Magnox awarded £743,512 to projects across the whole of Magnox to 129 organisations. Sizewell A allocated £103,506 in support of eight local organisations.

Magnox has been allocated £977,678 by the NDA to provide socio-economic support across the twelve sites for 2019/20. £6,000 has been allocated to each site for Good Neighbour Applications (up to £1,000). We already have multi-year funding projects committed for this year totalling £467,312 which, with the allocation of £72,000 for the Good Neighbour applications means that there is currently £438,366 available across the Magnox sites for applications above £1,000.
