Safety and environment



- Continue to adhere to Government guidance on Covid
- Regular campaigns focus on safety topics
- There has been three first aid incidents since last report
- In response to issue of motorbikes damaging nature trail we are:
 - installing additional warning signage
 - investigating barrier works to act as a deterrent

Safety and environment

- Magnox continues to work with Environment Agency following receipt of Radioactive Substances Compliance Assessment Report (RASCAR) relating to incident in 2019
- Approximately 200 litres of rainwater discovered in a container of low-level waste. This has now been appropriately consigned.

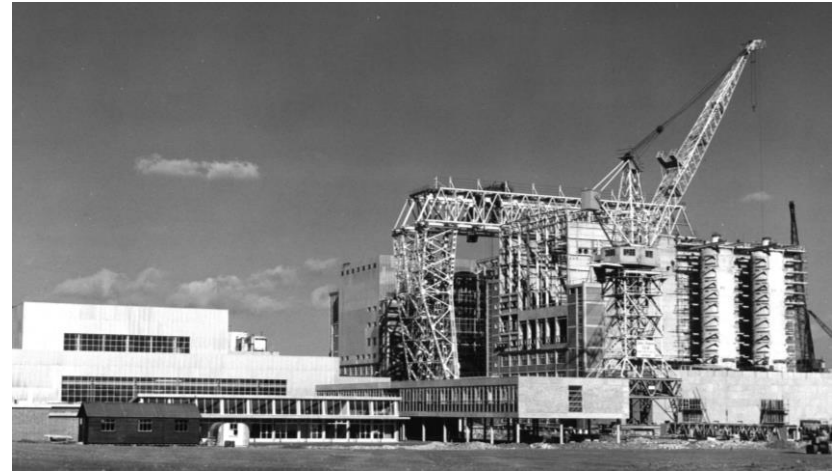
Bradwell annual inspection

- Completed three weeks ahead of schedule
- Around 200 routine tasks undertaken which included:
 - inspecting integrity of buildings, instrumentation and maintenance systems
 - in-service plant and equipment items maintenance



Bradwell – 60 years

- 60 years since start of power generation
- In its lifetime Bradwell generated:
 - nearly 60TWh of electricity – enough to power 15 million homes for a year
 - on an average day, enough electricity to power towns the size of Chelmsford, Colchester and Southend put together
